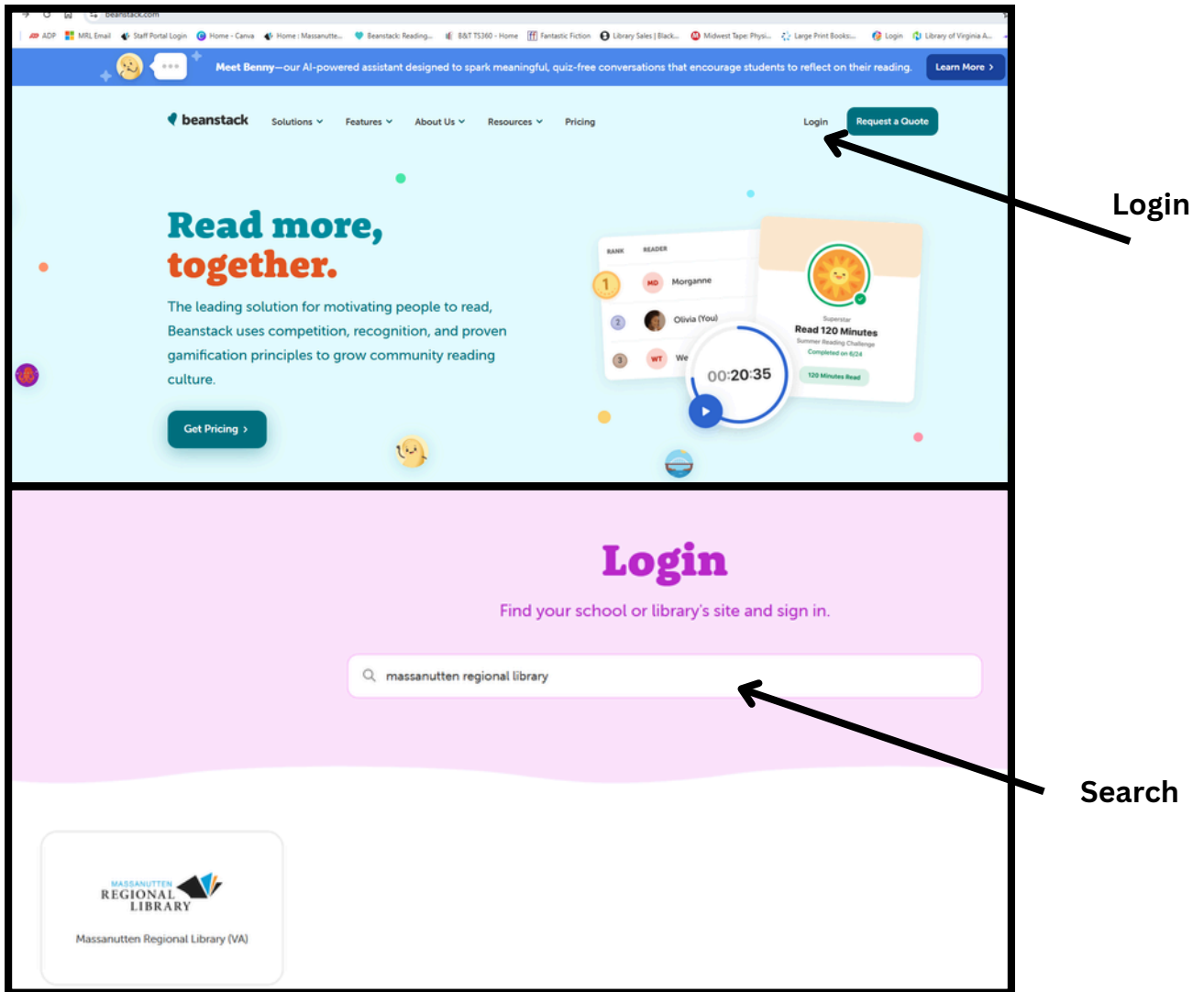
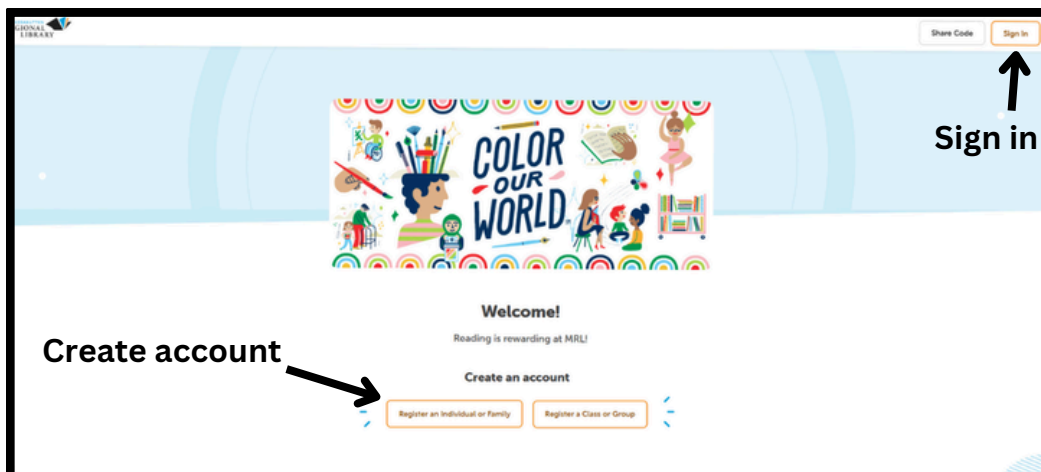


Summer Reading on a Desktop Computer

Type **beanstack.com** in the web browser. Click **Login** in top right corner and search for **Massanutten Regional Library**.



Once you click on Massanutten Regional Library, it will redirect you to our Beanstack page. From here, you can create an account or sign in to your account.



Creating an account

When you click **Register an individual or family**, you will first be asked if you have used Beanstack before. If you have, you will be taken to the sign in page. If you haven't, you will be able to start creating your account. All required information has a red asterisk beside it.

If registering a child, you will also be asked to provide their name and age.

Joining a challenge

Beanstack can be used to log reading at any time, but if there are any available challenges, they will show up here. Make sure you are enrolled in the summer reading challenge if you want your reading to count towards prizes.

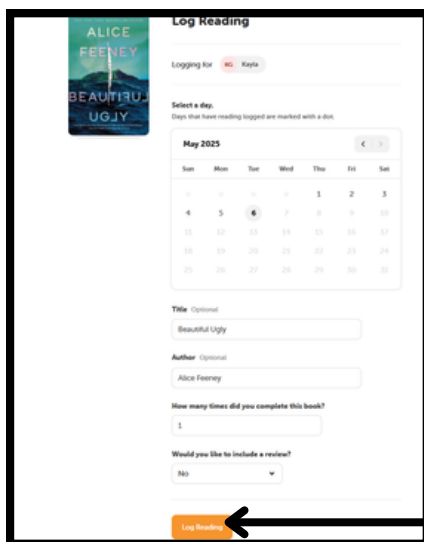
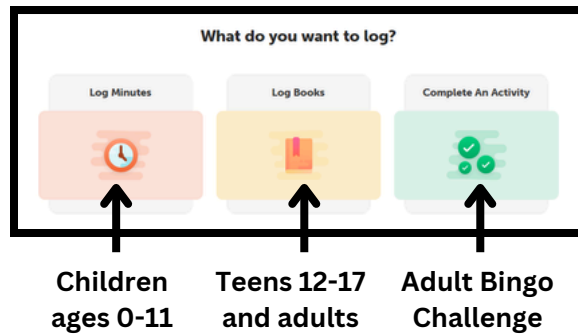
If you are creating a Beanstack account, you can register for the challenge here.

If you already have a Beanstack account, you should see the challenge under "More Challenges."

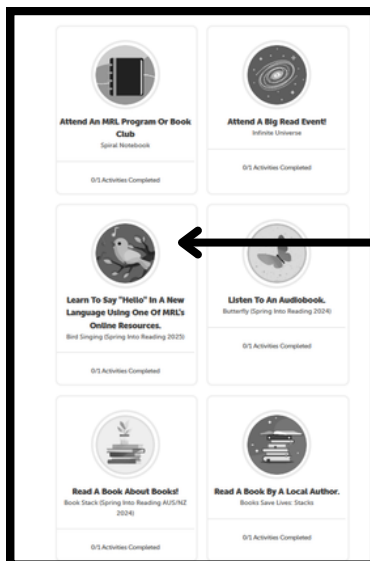
Logging Reading or Activities in Beanstack



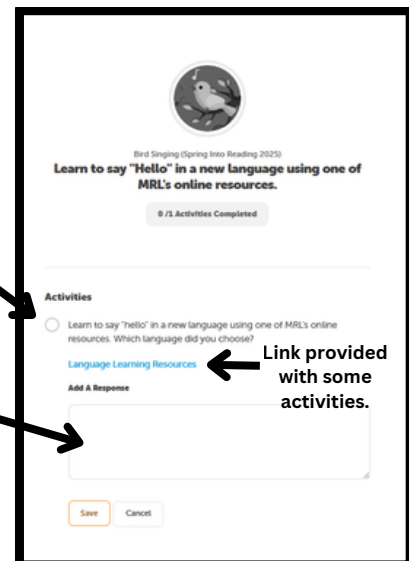
You'll be asked what you want to log. Children ages 0-11 will log minutes. Teens ages 12-17 and adults will log books.



You can list book titles and authors if you want to, but they are not required. You do need to type in how many times you read a book. **Please only log completed books.** You can track progress on books, but don't mark them as completed until you are done. Click the yellow **log reading** button to log your reading. Adults earn 1 ticket for each book they read and teens earn 2 tickets for each book read. Children earn 2 tickets for every 120 minutes they read. Once one of those milestones has been hit, the reader will earn a ticket(s) that they can enter into the raffle drawings for grand prizes.



Once you complete an activity, click on this circle. Some activities require a response so you will have to fill the text box before clicking the circle.



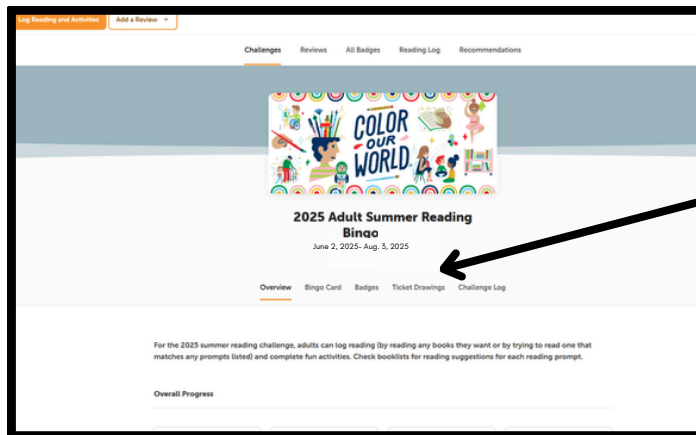
Prize information

Children ages 0-11: Log minutes spent reading or listening to books. Earn prizes, coupons for free food, and other goodies for every 120 minutes of reading. Read 600 minutes to receive coupons for free goodies and a free book. Every 120 minutes logged earns 2 tickets for the grand prize raffle.

Teens ages 12-17: Log books when you have finished reading. Earn prizes, coupons for free food, and other goodies for every book read. Read 5 books to receive more coupons for free goodies and a free book. Every book logged earns 2 tickets for the grand prize raffle.

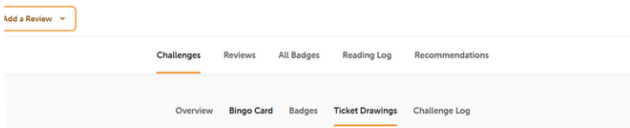
Adults: Adults are entered into weekly drawings for prizes for each book they log or activity they completed that week. Adults can get up to 27 tickets (no ticket for registration). Once you fill the Bingo board, you will have completed the summer reading challenge and you will no longer receive tickets.

Ticket Drawings

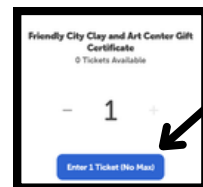
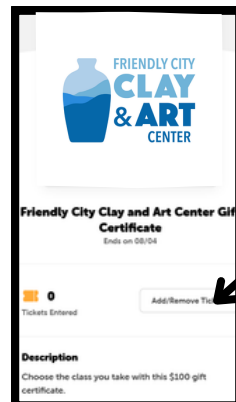
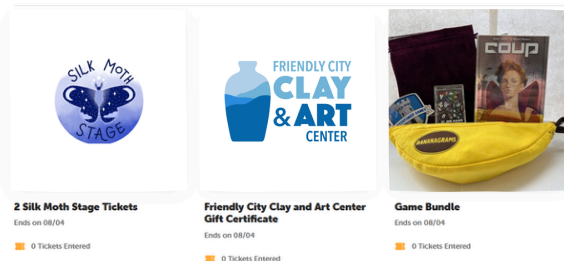


Click here to see tickets earned and enter into a prize raffle.

Click on the challenge you are participating in (ex. 2025 Adult Summer Reading). Once you have opened that challenge, you should see different options for badges, ticket drawings, and your challenge log. When you click on ticket drawings, you will see the different options for prizes. Click on the one you are interested in. Here you can adjust the number of tickets you would like to submit for that prize. Once you enter your ticket(s), you will get a notification that the ticket was entered. All tickets need to be entered by **August 3rd**.

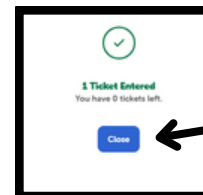
