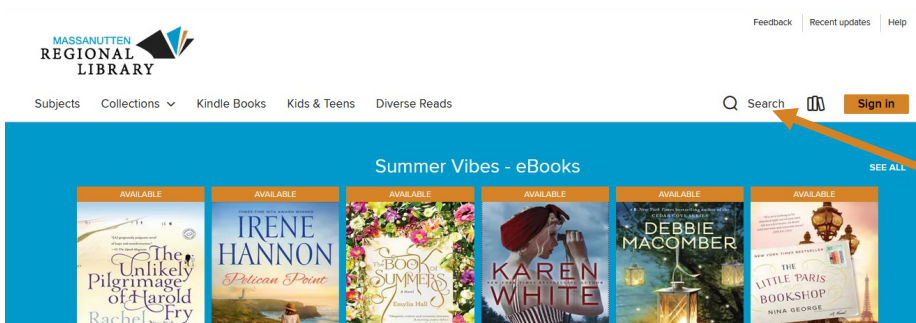


# OverDrive for Kindle



1. From the library's website ([www.mrlib.org](http://www.mrlib.org)), navigate to Downloadable Media > Overdrive. Or go straight to [www.mrl.overdrive.com](http://www.mrl.overdrive.com).

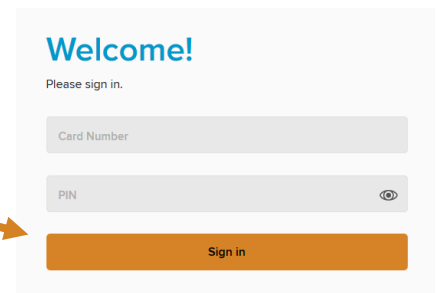


2. Browse for books on the home page, or use the **search box** to locate a specific title.

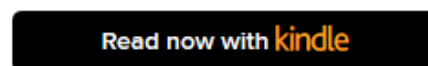
3. After locating the book you want, click **Borrow**.



4. Enter your library card number and 4-digit pin, then click **Sign In**. (You will have to click **Borrow** once more after signing in.)




5. A success message will appear in the center of the screen. In the message, click on **Read now with kindle**.




6. You will be redirected to Amazon. Enter the email address and password that you use for your **Amazon.com** account (not your library account). Then click **Sign in**.

7. Click on **Get Library Book** on the right side of the page.
